

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

APPLICATION:

- Rebate application must be filled out completely, truthfully and accurately. Applicant is advised to retain a copy of all applications and any accompanying documentation submitted to the Manufactured Housing Research Alliance (MHRA) under this program. MHRA is not responsible for lost documentation.
- Funds for the rebate are limited and available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Rebate applications must be received by MHRA on or before November 10, 2008.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Rebates are available only for new ENERGY STAR qualified manufactured homes sold to electric service customers of Southern California Edison. Only new construction qualifies. Modular homes do not qualify.
- Homes must be completed at the building site no later than October 31, 2008.
- For homes using natural gas or liquid petroleum gas as the primary heating energy source, any site-installed air conditioning equipment must be properly sized. For homes using electricity as the primary heating energy source, a properly sized heat pump must be installed.
- The applicant can not apply for or receive rebates from any other utility or state or local program for the ENERGY STAR qualified manufactured homes included in this application.

PAYMENT:

- Information about the home must be entered by the home manufacturer into the MHRA ENERGY STAR Information Manager™ before the rebate application will be processed.
- Payment of the rebate is conditional on verification by MHRA that the home is connected to Southern California Edison's electric service.
- MHRA may conduct an on-site inspection of the home to verify it has been installed (including all required heating/cooling equipment) in compliance with program requirements and completed prior to payment of the rebate.
