



ENERGY STAR® Modular Homes

Steps for the Plant

Step 1

Sign up for the program

Read, sign and submit to SBRA the [ENERGY STAR Modular Homes Program Registration Form](#).¹

Step 2

Certify the plant

Retain a plant Certifier to assist in qualifying the plant for ENERGY STAR production. Review [ENERGY STAR Modular Homes Compliance Procedures](#).

Step 3

Complete Partnership Agreement

Submit an [ENERGY STAR Partnership Agreement](#) to EPA to gain access to ENERGY STAR marketing materials and to be listed in the ENERGY STAR partner locator.

Step 4

Order quality assurance (QA) labels

Every ENERGY STAR modular home requires an SBRA quality assurance (QA) label applied in the plant and an ENERGY STAR Qualified Home label applied in the field. To order QA labels, complete the [Label Order Form](#). The field label will be provided upon completion of the home on the site.

Step 5

Build and ship homes

Apply a QA label to each ENERGY STAR home. Deliver home with a partially-completed and signed [Inspection Checklist for ENERGY STAR Qualified Modular Home](#).

Step 6

Report production data

Provide basic information about homes produced to SBRA.
