



Certifying ENERGY STAR[®] Homes

Using the Alternative Compliance Path for Electrically Heated Manufactured Homes with Heat Pumps

Step 1 Verify Heat Pump Sale with Retailer

Confirm that a heat pump has been sold for the ENERGY STAR home.

Step 2 Design and Manufacture ENERGY STAR Home

Build the home per the requirements specified in Appendix E:

Step 3 Create Home Record in *Information Manager*

Select '3-Custom Electric' from the design package drop-down.

Step 4 Collect Heat Pump Information

Provide a **Heat Pump Tracking Sheet** to the retailer or HVAC distributor to record the heat pump brand name and model numbers.

Step 5 Add Heat Pump Data to *Information Manager*

Update the home record in Information Manager (IM) with the heat pump brand and model numbers.

Note: IM is currently being updated to include the new data fields. In the meantime, please save a copy of all heat pump data.

Step 6 Complete & Affix Labels to Home

Manufacturers are responsible for ensuring their field representative affixes to the home the **ENERGY STAR Certified Home** and signed **SBRA Quality Assurance** labels.
